Tfl Digital Signs Project

A major infrastructure project for Transport for London, consuming real time bus arrival data for 18,000 bus stops across London, and making the data available on the web. Designed to cope with extremely high levels of traffic, and for near-100% uptime, with an extremely robust testing and rollout service to manage upgrades to the service without interruption to service delivery.

NudgeCRM

A platform for Pub/Bar/Restaurant operators to provide full ECRM facilities across their estates, deployed with a service oriented architecture, so that the components of the platform can be deployed and customised bespoke to each operator.

A Laravel application, integrating via API and other means with a variety of third party and internal tooling. (For example: Gitlab, PHPCI and Deployer, along with internal scripting.)

Feb 2009 – July 2016

Employed by NudgeCRM as Head of Application Development. The role involves a mixture of team leadership, technical planning, product management (determining new feature rollout for the company's primary product), project management, (often across multiple simultaneous projects for multiple clients), and some hands-on coding.

Key projects:

- Lead team responsible for delivery of the NudgeCRM application, a booking/restaurant management/CRM platform for restaurants and bars. PHP/JS/Postgres/Memcached development with a modular SOA design to be deployed as individual client installations sharing a common, extensible core that can continue to be extended and developed so that clients get the benefits of new functionality, but can retain their individual customisations.
- REST/JSON API design for the NudgeCRM application.
- Deployment automation using OpenVZ and Sprinkle.
- Internal Processes - championed adoption of Agile methodology and TDD/BDD practices.

Employed by Aardvark Media as Senior Developer in an OO-PHP/PostgreSQL environment, working on a full CMS/ECRM/E-commerce systems for a number of agency clients, which involved implementing a custom application development framework in PHP.
